- No Point Gap
- Only From Men's Bronze medal & Gold Medal contest (2 minute x 5 rounds), when contestant receive 20 gam-jeom, the referee shall declare the contestant loser by referee's punitive declaration (PUN)

DURATION OF A MATCH:



Two points will be added to the successful turning kick scored by PSS:

- 1. Turning kick to the trunk protector: 2 + 2 = 4
- 2. Turning kick to the head: 3 + 2 = 5

Please note Corner Judges will stand up and add the 2 points, if they miss pressing for the technical points.

Coach can request IVR to add technical points or invalidate technical points.

TECHNICAL POINTS FOR TURNING KICKS:

COMPETITION RULES

- 4 points for valid turning kick to PSS Trunk
- 5 points for valid turning kick to PSS Head
- Additional 5 points when referee counts for knock down
- Gam-jeom shall be declared when one foot of contestant
 - cross the boundary line.





- If one foot is totally out of the boundary line and touches the mat, the
 player will be penalized with a Gam-Jeom.
- If the foot does not touch the mat, no Gam-Jeom will be given.
- If the player scores point(s) with one foot out, before referee declares
 Kal-yeo, he/she will be penalized with a Gam Jeom but the point(s) will
 stay.
- The same applies if opponent scores when player is out with one foot, before referee declares Kal-yeo, the point(s) will stay but the player will receive a Gam Jeom.

ONE FOOT OUT OF BOUNDARY LINE:




It is tolerated when the player's arm(s) pass his/her opponent's body position as long as there is

- 1. no MONKEY KICK;
- 2. no grabbing the sleeve(s) or the hogu of the opponent;
- 3. no squeezing, no controlling, no moving the opponent around;
- 4. no wrapping the arm around opponent's neck;
- 5. no curling the opponent's lower body with player's leg.

If points are scored, they will be invalidated and Gam-Jeom given.

GRABBING:



A knock down (+5 points) shall be declared, When a legal attack is delivered and:

- When any part of the body other than sole of the foot touches the floor due to the force of the opponent's scoring technique
- 2. When a contestant is staggered and shows no intention or ability to continue as a result of the opponent's scoring techniques
- 3. When the referee judges that the contest can not continue as the result of being struck by <u>legal scoring technique</u>

KNOCK DOWN



If Centre Referee perceives a player has been knocked down by a legal attack is delivered (KICK or Punch) to the scoring area, referee will start counting and the attacker will get additional 5 points.

1. If the player is knocked down by a <u>strong "Face or Head Kick" even for Body PSS Kick</u> with no points scored, the Centre Referee must count up to 8 and request IVR on behalf of the attacker for the 3 or 5 points for Head and 2 or 4 points for body. In this case, if the kick is legal, the Video Juror will instruct the Referee to add the points with the additional 5 points. If the player falls down from the legal kick, he will receive a Gam Jeom.

EXTRA POINTS FOR KNOCKING DOWN OPPONENT:

Pain is not injury!!!



Calling Doctor and Kyeshi will be given to the injured player only if there is:

- 1. Bleeding
- 2. Dislocation of joint or broken bone
- 3. Twisted ankle
- 4. Strong Punch to the face or strong Kick to the groin.
- If a contestant falls, the referee shall command "stand up" 3 times at 3 second intervals.
- When the contestant stands up a Gam-Jeom will be given. (If he is kicked below the waist and caused him to fall, the opponent shall receive the Gam-Jeom.)
- If the contestant refuses to stand up in the 9 seconds described above, the referee will
 give Gam-Jeom, then Keuman; and the opponent will be declared the winner by RSC.

PAIN OR INJURY



All WT penalties (Gam Jeoms) will apply in the Championships.
